

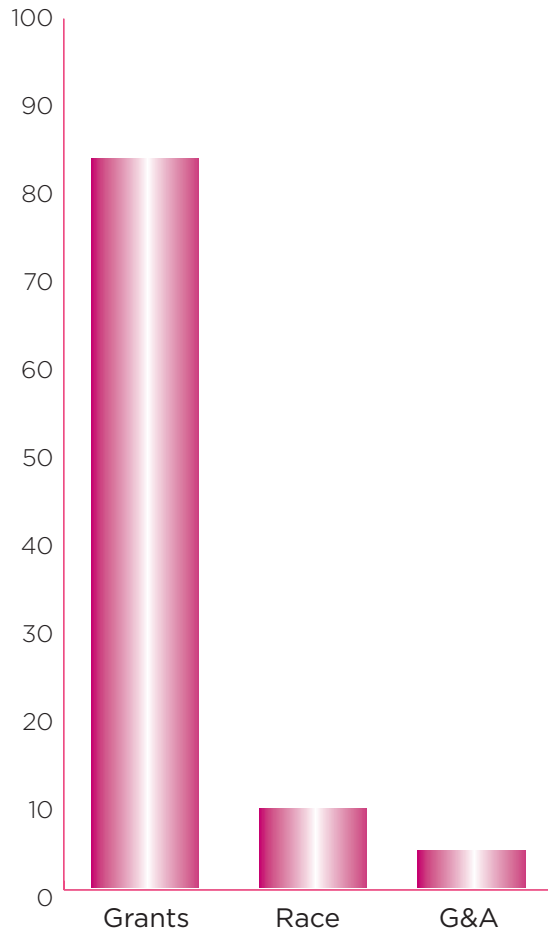

Grant Recipients 2008 - 2009

North Texas Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure®

American Cancer Society (ACS)

This grant will provide vouchers for breast prosthesis, bras, and wigs for underserved breast cancer patients in Collin, Denton, and Grayson counties. The ACS will provide a breast cancer education campaign through churches and community organizations in all three counties.

Bridge of Blessings

The mission of Bridge of Blessings is to provide temporary financial assistance to qualified individuals in the North Texas area who are undergoing treatment for breast and other cancers.

The Bridge Breast Network

The Bridge Breast Network provides diagnostic and treatment services needed to bridge the gap to access for low income, uninsured, and underserved North Texans who may have breast cancer. They offer direct and indirect services to individuals with breast health concerns through community outreach and education, medical case management, counseling, breast health information and, most importantly, life saving breast cancer services.

Collin County Health Care Services

Collin County Health Care Services has been involved in breast screening and education programs for the past six years. Their project will include free clinic breast screening, mammograms, and education programs.

Denton County Health Department

Denton County Health Department's "Mammogram Project" is to improve access to breast cancer early detection screening for qualifying women. 100% of women who meet the qualifications of the project will be given a lowcost mammogram.

Easter Seals of Greater Dallas

"Reflections" is the program of Easter Seals North Texas. Reflections' goal is to assist women to feel more comfortable and look the way they prefer to look following treatment for breast cancer and to overcome many of the social, economic, and emotional challenges presented by their disease and their health status.

Family Health Care, Inc.

Family Health Care will utilize funds to provide routine & diagnostic breast screening to uninsured women in Denton county. Women who are 40 years & older will be offered screening mammograms at annual exams, diagnostic exams & biopsies will be made available to those with suspicious symptoms.

Gilda's Club North Texas

A unique program of support & networking groups, education & social support, Gilda's Club provides vital services to breast & other cancer patients. Gilda's Club will open a satellite clubhouse in Allen, Texas in late 2008.

Grayson County Health Department

The program of Grayson County Health Department, "Early Detection and Patient Care of Medically Underserved Grayson County Women", focuses on breast health education, screening, and patient care/support services.

Presbyterian Hospital of Allen

The goal of Presbyterian Hospital of Allen's "Better Breast Health Program" is to bring breast health education and screening to underserved populations, including the growing African American & Hispanic population in Collin County. Breast health education, including self exam, computerized breast cancer risk assessments & mammograms will be provided.

Richardson Regional Medical Center

The activities of Richardson Regional Medical Center's "Asian Breast Health Outreach Project" are designed to reach an underserved priority group of Asian women located in Collin and Denton counties. The focus is to minimize the barriers that keep Asian women from fully participating in early detection and preventive breast health.

Texas Women's University

Texas Women's University's "Pioneer Breast Health and Community Outreach Program of Denton County" is a multi-faceted program aimed at increasing knowledge, changing attitudes and increasing mammography rates in Denton County.

Texoma Health Foundation

The program of Texoma Health Foundation is targeted for medically underserved women of Grayson County to access free screening mammograms, diagnostic mammograms, ultrasounds & followup visits to the physicians who perform biopsies & surgeries for these patients.
